

Figure 1 is a plot showing the E-W Direction [AU] versus the Sun-Earth Direction [AU]. The Sun is at (0,0) and Earth is at (1,0). Concentric dashed circles represent distances from the Sun at 0.25, 0.5, 0.75, and 1.0 AU. Solid circles represent IDPs, and open circles represent meteorites. Most IDPs are clustered between 0.2 and 0.8 AU from the Sun and -0.25 to 0.25 AU in the E-W direction. Meteorites are more widely distributed, with some near Earth's orbit.
